DAY 1

Arrival to Zagreb.
Transfer from the airport to your hotel.
Overnight at the hotel in Zagreb area.

DAY 2

Breakfast at the hotel.

Zagreb sightseeing tour with local guide (duration; approx. 2,5 hrs)

Zagreb grew up on two neighbouring hills: Kaptol - the centre of spiritual and religious life of north-western Croatia and Gradec - the commercial centre of skilful tradesmen and craftsmen. Visit the Upper Town with its Gothic Cathedral, the beautiful and ornate St. Catherine's church or the massive St. Mark's church with its famous colour-tiled roof. Continue to the medieval Stone Gate and "Dolac", the open-air market which are a must for all visitors.

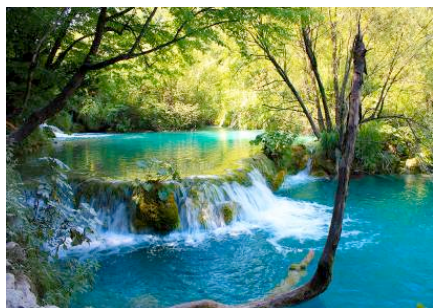
Free time for lunch on own and exploring the city.

DAY 3

Breakfast at the hotel.
Transfer from Zagreb to Plitvice National Park.

Visit of Plitvice National Park with local guide (duration; approx. 3 hrs)



Plitvice National Park is one of the most beautiful and best preserved national parks in the country. This is why the entire lakes and surrounding area were declared a national park in 1949 and are listed on the UNESCO's list of World Heritage Sites because of its exceptional beauty. It is a valley situated between high forested mountains in which lie, one below

another, a string of sixteen beautiful lakes of crystal blue and green waters. Fed by small streams and brooks, they spill into each other in

92 foaming cascades and thundering waterfalls. The lakes themselves cover about 2 square kilometres and the entire national park covers 200 square kilometres. The Plitvice lakes' scenery will simply delight you regardless whether you are walking the paths and wooden bridges, taking a boat ride or just taking photographs.

After a day in nature, your transfer will continue to Opatija.
Overnight at the hotel in Opatija area.

DAY 4

Breakfast at the hotel.

Today you will visit Istrian peninsula:

Istria tour with local guide (duration approx. 8hrs)

Pula - The largest town on the Istrian peninsula offers a diversity of attractions to lovers of culture. The rich itinerary of its three thousand year old history, where every step you take through the old town is a landmark, begins and ends with the Roman amphitheatre, one of the best preserved Roman amphitheatres in the world. Rovinj – a typical medieval Venetian town, distinctive for its romantic narrow little streets and the imposing church of its patron saint, St. Euphemia. Overnight at the hotel in Opatija area.



DAY 5

Breakfast at the hotel.

Transfer from Opatija to Zadar. (Duration approximately 3 hours)

Zadar sightseeing tour with local guide (duration approx. 1,5hrs)

Zadar is the oldest Slavic city on the Adriatic Coast with many historical monuments such as Roman Forum, St. Donat's Church, Square of the 5 Wells, Saint Anastasia's Cathedral, etc.

At the end of the Western Quay is Zadar's newest feature, the Sea Organ which is powered by the wind and the sea. (duration approx. 1,5h)

Free time on own.

Transfer continues to Split. (Duration approximately 1,5 hours)

Overnight at the hotel in Split area.



DAY 6

Breakfast at the hotel.

Split sightseeing tour with local guide (duration approx. 2,5 hrs)

The old town of Split is built on and around the spectacular Roman Palace erected by the Roman Emperor Diocletian (born in Salona – today's Solin) in the 4th century. The walking tour starts with a visit to the cellars of the Palace that are still very well preserved. The cellars offer a good view at how the life in the Palace was organized. Other sites such as the Golden Gate, the Silver Gate, the Peristyle Square etc. will be seen from the outside.

Free time for lunch and to explore Split on own.

Overnight at the hotel in Split area.



DAY 7



Breakfast at the hotel.

Excursion to island of Hvar.

Full day excursions to Hvar with local guide:

When we think of Hvar - we think about the island of heather, sunshine and crickets, the island of lavender, sage and wine and the island of rosemary and secluded coves.

Return to Split. Overnight at the hotel in Split area.

Possibility of full day excursion on luxury yacht (prebooked).

DAY 8

Transfer from Split to Dubrovnik up the coast to the Peljesac peninsula.

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We will have an opportunity to stop in Ston - a small town known by a five-kilometre long wall (with a total of forty one towers and seven bastions), salt pans (a vital source of income for the Republic of Dubrovnik and they are still used today just as they were five centuries ago) and high quality oysters.

Transfer to Dubrovnik.

Overnight at the hotel in Dubrovnik area.

DAY 9

Breakfast at the hotel.

Dubrovnik sightseeing tour with local guide (duration approx. 2 hrs)

The walking portion includes visits to the Dominican Monastery with its fine collection of medieval paintings and the Cathedral with its famous Treasury.
